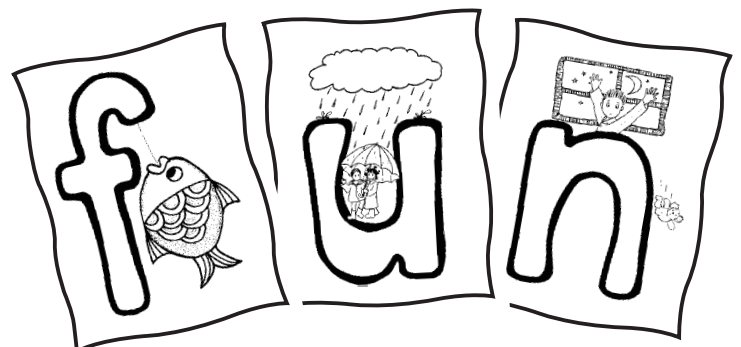

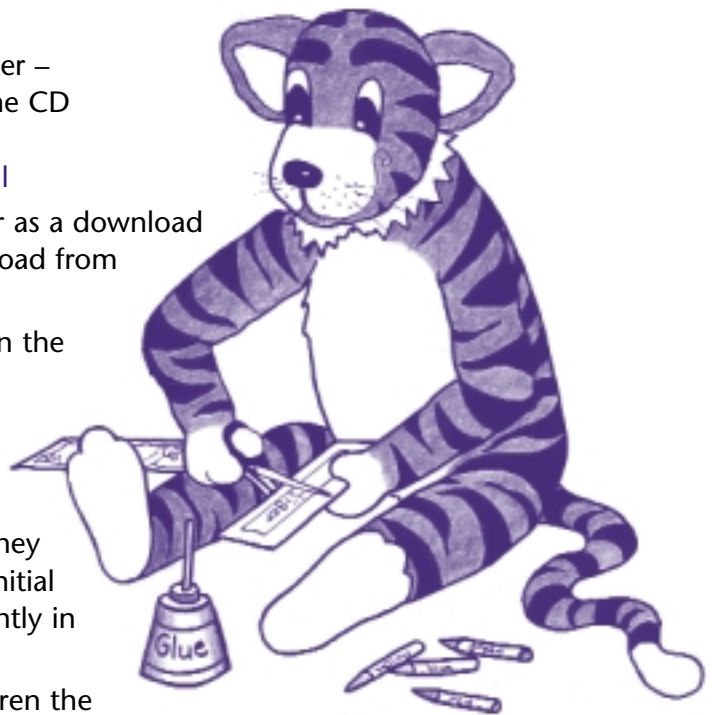
- 2. The **Jazzles 'Alphabet Collage' book** to help children understand and recall letter shapes.

Key Suggestion

To optimize the learning of letters and their sounds, focus on just one alphabet letter a week.

- a) Refer to **Page 3 of the 'Alphabet Activity Sheet' book** for the recommended order of learning letters. This order is preferable to following the standard alphabet order (as in A,B,C, etc) because, once children know a group of sounds – such as a, m, s and t, it allows them to practise the skill of blending the learnt sounds – e.g am or sat
- b) Use each of these resources to teach each letter:-
 - 1. The alphabet letter **song** on the CD.
 - 2. The relevant song **lyric sheet** for the letter – available as a download on the CD, in the CD booklet or as website download from <http://www.jazzles.com/html/letters.html>
 - 3. The relevant **coloring page** for the letter as a download available on the CD or as website download from <http://www.jazzles.com/html/color.html>.
 - 4. The relevant **collage page** to be found in the enclosed 'Alphabet Collage' book.
 - 5. The relevant alphabet **activity sheet** to be found in the enclosed 'Alphabet Activity Sheets' book.
- c) Let your children play the CD as often as they like. This helps them hear and learn each initial sound which you will find repeated frequently in each song.
- d) 'Alphapazzazz' is a song that teaches children the order of the alphabet.



You will be surprised at your child's progress and, as an idea for a visual record, just create a simple **alphabet chart**. Then, as each letter and its sound is learnt, put an **achievement sticker** next to the successfully learnt letter. Everyone can then admire their progress!

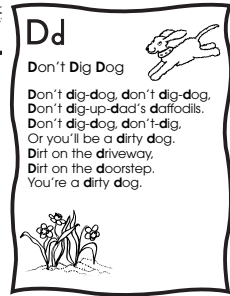
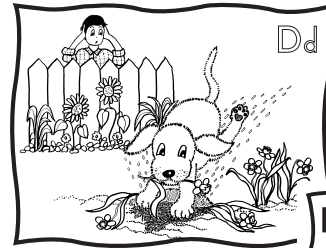
Suggested Use of these Jazzles Resources



1. Using the Jazzles Alphabet CD-CDROM

- i). Show children the letter they are going to learn. (Reference the large letter in the Collage Book.) Play the CD and learn the relevant song. Add movement, clapping, clicks or instruments as appropriate.
- ii) Download the relevant Coloring Page to discuss the meaning of the lyrics and so build comprehension of the words. Find and discuss pictures that begin with the letter. Color or paint the picture(s).
- iii) Download the relevant Song Lyric Page from the CD and let children highlight all the initial sounds. Help your children point to each word as they sing the song.

2. Using the Jazzles Alphabet Collage Book

This book provides fun collage suggestions for each alphabet letter.

Use the relevant page to collage the letter you are focusing upon. Encourage children to completely collage the whole area of each letter.

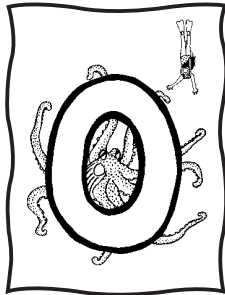
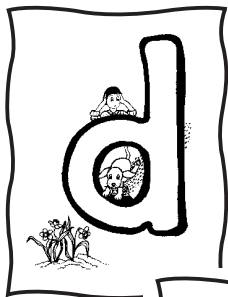
This will help their understanding of letter shapes. There are some Jazzles collage suggestions for each page that helps children link words to textural materials that begin with the same letter. See pages 3 & 4.

When you collage, I suggest you use lightweight materials. If you want to use heavier collage materials, you will need to photocopy the page and mount it on card before collaging.

Suggested lightweight materials include:

- **From the kitchen** - flour, coconut, poppy and sesame seeds, dried herbs, pot-pourri, sugar, chocolate powder, cake decorating materials.
- **From about the home** - all varieties of fabric, lace, cottons, wools, ribbons, cotton wool, stickers and glitter. Also all varieties of paper including colored paper or picture areas from newspapers and magazines – torn or cut into shapes such as letters, squares, oblongs, diamonds, triangles, circles, etc.

- **From the environment** - grass, leaves, soil, fine sand, small seeds and flower petals.
- Also add scented oils to the collaged letter to add the sense of smell.



3. Using the Jazzles 'Alphabet Activity Sheets' Book

This book is full of cutting, pasting, coloring and tracing that relate to the relevant song. These activities provide children with practical experience in the use of each letter in a variety of reading and writing experiences to further develop their understanding of sound-letter relationships.

The book's activities are graded in difficulty if taught in the suggested order for teaching the letters. This order, featured on Page 3 of the book, is arranged in groupings of one vowel to several consonants.



★ Extra Fun Ideas!

Here are some additional fun activities to reinforce letter shapes, sounds and the meaning of words beginning with the week's focus letter.

- Play 'I Spy' about the target letter at home and outdoors.
- Take the target letter song and create a **dance** or 'mini play' around it – complete with **costumes and masks** as appropriate.
- **Make 3D objects** around the songs using recycled materials, play dough, clay or plasticine. For example, make a snake, dinosaur, or yellow yacht etc.
- **Bake cookies** shaping the mixture into letter shapes.
- Decorate cup cakes using the beginning letters of the names of family and friends.
- **Borrow books from the library** with titles beginning with the targeted letter of the week.
- **Create a chart or theme book** around words beginning with the targeted letter. For example,
 - > "G" – create a green book featuring green objects.
 - > "H" – create a chart featuring different types of hats.
 - > "D" – cut and paste different types of dogs into a book or on a chart. Children really love doing this!
 - > Now draw large and lower case letters for the book cover.
- Find and cut out **letters** from magazines and newspapers.
- **Make hanging 'word banks'** using strips of ribbon or crepe paper. (Refer to the picture on Page 5 of the 'Alphabet Collage' Book).



★ How can I use my CD-ROM drive to play the audio files?

From your Program Manager, start up your audio player which will then recognize the audio tracks and play from there.

★ Instructions for Downloading from the CD-CDROM

The Jazzles song lyric sheets, in a choice of US English or UK/AUS English, and their related coloring pages, are included as two Adobe Acrobat PDF 'ebooks' on the enclosed Jazzles 'Alphabet Clever Songs' CD. These PDF 'ebooks' work on all operating systems including Microsoft Windows and Apple Mac.

You will need *Acrobat Reader 3.0* or higher to open, read, and print out these self explanatory files. If you don't already have this software, you can access the Windows 98 version from this CD or download it for free at www.adobe.com.

Follow the instructions below to access these two Adobe ebooks from this CD.

- Quit all open applications.
- Insert Jazzles CD into your CD-ROM drive. It should start up automatically.
- If the CD doesn't start automatically, select Start/Run... from the Windows Toolbar and type d:\start\start where d: is the drive letter of your CD-ROM.
- Or, through file manager, double click on your CD-Rom drive to access the readme.txt file. The Lyrics and Coloring 'Books' are in the folders of the same names.

If you still can't find the PDF files on the CD, try one of the following...

- Try using the CD in a PC with a newer CD-ROM Drive
- Go to <http://www.jazzles.com/html/download.html> where the computer data has been compressed into various downloadable files.
- Take the CD to a print shop which will be able to open and print the files for you.
